



## **LOW COST HEALTH PROVIDERS FOR PHYSICAL CONDITIONS JOPLIN AREA**

The following providers treat physical medical conditions and provide free or low cost medical care, or accept Medicaid patients. To find out what medical services you may be eligible for, you should contact these providers directly.

An application for Medical Assistance or Medicaid may be filed at the Division of Family Services office in the county where you live. A Medicaid card will allow you to seek treatment from any health care provider that accepts Medicaid payments.
