



LOW COST HEALTH PROVIDERS FOR PHYSICAL CONDITIONS WICHITA AREA

The following providers treat physical medical conditions and provide free or low cost medical care, or accept Medicaid patients. To find out what medical services you may be eligible for, you should contact these providers directly.

An application for Medical Assistance or Medicaid may be filed at the Kansas Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services office in the county where you live. A Medicaid card will allow you to seek treatment from any health care provider that accepts Medicaid payments.

If you already have Medicaid benefits and have difficulty getting to and from your doctor appointments, you can contact the Medicaid Transportation Service at (888) 863-9513 to arrange a ride. Be sure to call well in advance of your scheduled doctor appointment.
